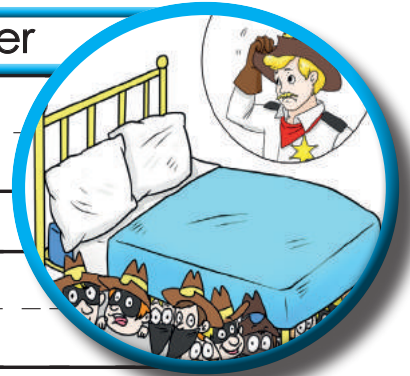


Prepositions are a words (often a short words) that express the relationship between two other nearby words. A preposition comes before a noun (or a pronoun) to show the noun's (or the pronoun's) relationship to another word in the sentence. Prepositions can help us know the time, place and relation of two nouns.

There are many prepositions, common prepositions include: **under, over, on, in, beside, between, and by** but there are many more.
