

Adjectives are words that describe nouns. A noun is a person, place or thing.

For example: He is a tall boy.

*tall describes the boy

Some adjectives tell what kind of noun. Some adjectives tell how many there are.

For example: The smart girl has many books.

*smart tell us what kind of girl and many tells us about the amount of books
